

CISC Player Cards

All players, ages seven and above, in Carroll Indoor soccer leagues will be required to have a player card. The player card will: 1. Verify the player's age and grade and ensure that he/she is playing in appropriate age division 2. Ensure that players are on the roster and playing for only one team within a division 3. Help CISC keep current emergency contact information on all players in case of serious injury 4. Help officials identify red carded players so they can be dealt with by management

Getting a card: Cards will be issued at the office. Each player will need to fill out a registration/waiver form and provide proof of age. Photos will be taken and cards issued at time of registration.

Cost of card: Cost of the card is \$10. for player's primary team and \$5 for each additional age division that the player is playing in. Cards will expire on August 31, 2014. However, if a player was issued a card for the 2012-13 season, the cost will be \$5 per team.

Proof of age: A player's age may be verified through any government issued ID with birthdate including driver's license, birth certificate, passport, etc. For youth divisions MSYSA player cards may also be used for age verification. Verification is a one time only requirement. Once a player has verified his/her age with Carroll Indoor, verification will not be required in future years.

Game procedure: All players will be required to give their player card to the game referee prior to the game. Cards will be given back to the team coach/captain at the conclusion of the game unless a red card is issued. A player who receives a red card must check in with office concerning any possible game suspensions. His/her card will be returned after the suspension is served.

Lost/forgotten cards: If a player loses his/her card, a replacement will be issued. If a player forgets his card, a temporary card will be issued. Replacement card is \$5, a temporary card is \$1. The replacement or temporary card must be obtained prior to game.

Changing teams: Players who choose to change teams within a division must secure a new card for their new team. The old card must be returned to the office. Cost will be \$5. After a player has played for one team in a session, he/she may not change teams within that division until after the session has ended.

Rosters: Teams will no longer be required to submit rosters. When a player registers for a player card, his/her name will automatically be added to the team roster.

Carroll Indoor is aware that obtaining and carrying player cards may be an inconvenience, especially in the first year. However, we feel the advantages far outweigh the disadvantages. We hear from some that "we just want to play and have fun". Unfortunately, more and more players are ignoring our rules concerning ages and playing on multiple teams. For all to have fun, all must play by the same rules.
